- High School graduate from any high school in Escambia County that actively belongs to an Undergraduate Chapter of National Pan-Hellenic Council.
- Currently pursuing a Bachelor's or Master's degree at any accredited Post-Secondary institution *must be in good-standing with college/university.
- Submission of official school transcript (with official raised stamp) showing a 2.5 GPA or higher for Undergraduate students or a 3.0 GPA or higher for Graduate students.
- Submission of one SIGNED letter of recommendation on OFFICIAL LETTERHEAD (must be from an active, financial member of your organization).
- Submission of verified community service hours/programs in which you have presided over or assisted in (minimum 25 hours)
- Submission of a typed essay approximately 500 words in length answering the provided essay questions in the Scholarship Application packet.
